



Parking Lot Traffic Flow Procedures

For the safety of all of our students and drivers, we ask families of all of our PS-8 students to abide by the following traffic flow guidelines. Each detail is very important.

- * Traffic flows counterclockwise through the parking lot's main loop. We are the **ALS dolphins, not salmon**; don't be the one to drive "upstream". Follow the flow diagram below. When leaving, continue the loop - don't go back the way you came.
- * Both when dropping students off in the morning and when picking students up in the afternoon, park in a parking stall. **There is no drive-by drop-off or pick-up.**
- * At the start of a school year, the parking reserved for **handicapped needs** are clearly marked and visible. *They still exist when the snow covers the paint.* We ask that you **not** park in any of those stalls unless you physically require them. Thank you for your cooperation.
- * Finally, at all times, drive **attentively** and **slowly** when proceeding through the parking lot. Watch for other cars, and especially **watch for children**. We have two crosswalks for crossing to the middle of the parking lot, and we ask adults and children to limit their crossing to those locations during our peak traffic times (8:45-9:00 a.m., 3:30-3:45 p.m.).
